IMPORTANT TECHNOLOGY UPDATE

Dear Mornings Star Members,

We want to share an important update following our meeting on Monday, September 15th, with our insurance representatives and a team of experts who have been working closely with us. Present at the meeting were Pastor John, Mel Hawke, David Kobe, along with Mike Toman and Christian Torres from Tardigrade, Melissa Lin, our insurance company's breach attorney, and Steven Greenawalt, the cyber-crime expert from Cybir representing our insurance company.

We are grateful to report that all experts have confirmed there was **no unauthorized access or breach** of MSLC's IT systems. We are thankful for the vigilance of our team; our systems remain secure and uncompromised—there was no hacking via our Wi-Fi or any other means. Further, all financial systems and member's personal information were not compromised and remain protected. Consequently, the insurance company will be closing the claim.

Melissa Lin expressed appreciation for the quick action taken by Pastor John in promptly filing the claim and taking the necessary steps to safeguard our technology infrastructure. She also praised the dedicated work of Tardigrade and our faithful volunteers, who acted swiftly to protect both the financial and personal information of our staff and congregation members.

We also officially welcomed the support of AT-Net as our ongoing IT provider on September 15. They will be on-site Wednesday, September 17 to begin the installation and configuration of enhanced security systems and protocols to further protect our church's digital environment.

Lastly, we are in the process of formally withdrawing the FBI and Police Reports previously filed concerning Beacon Technology.

Thank you all for your prayers, encouragement, and support throughout this challenging time. It is a true blessing to serve alongside each of you at MSLC. Rest assured, our IT systems are now fully secure and operational. We are on track to restore the worship center's audio-visual systems and live streaming capabilities by October 5th so that we can continue to connect and worship together.


