UPDATES FROM THE SYNOD

At the recent NC Synod Assembly, the **Rev. Emily Hartner** (former pastor of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church) was elected the next **Bishop of the NC Synod**. She began her six-year term on August 1, 2025.

Pastor Carolyn Hayford, has been named Interim Pastor at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Charlotte. Pastor Carolyn will help guide Holy Trinity through the transition and call process for a new pastor.

During the 2025 ELCA Churchwide Assembly, **Pastor Lucille** "CeCee" Mills was elected to serve a six-year term as secretary of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America . Pastor CeCee has served as an Assistant to the Bishop in North Carolina since 2019. She will be the first ELCA secretary of African descent.
